Adjacent to her school stands a Baptist Church, a place she holds dear. She found immense joy in attending this church, as it actively engages in numerous mission activities. What's more, it welcomes missionaries from the U.S.A who share the teachings of the Bible with them, enriching their spiritual journey.

Christyn's journey took a significant turn when she began serving in the Music Ministry. However, a tragic event, the passing of her father, compelled her to relocate to another town.
