HOME HEALTH AIDE (HHA) PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Program Objective

The objective of the Home Health Aide Program is to qualify students to work in an agency and assist patients with Medicare and Medicaid. Upon successful completion of the program and all financial obligations met the Institute will issue a diploma to the student.

Program Length

The Hemodialysis program is a total of 75 clock hours. Full-time students will complete the program in 4 weeks. Part-time students will complete the program within 8 weeks.
